

Tools for Transformation: Psychoenergetic Science

In this interactive session we explore the energy-based multidimensional model of William Tiller, PhD, and what it contributes to the art and science of therapeutic transformation. Tiller's model is reflected in many ancient wisdom traditions, such as Traditional Chinese Medicine and the Eastern life sciences, to which energy psychology traces its roots. The model is widely used among researchers of subtle energy phenomena and serves as a foundational model for understanding the human within a larger energy-based framework, extending incrementally from the individual to the universal levels.

Examining the Tillerian model and its application in clinical settings is relevant to the conference theme, the Art & Science of Transformational Change, as it is a science-based model of subtle energies that has significant explanatory value in terms of understanding the art of applied energetics. Dr. Tiller's work has received special recognition by ACEP, as recently he was awarded the *ACEP Contributions to the Field* award. His multidimensional model, in particular, has pragmatic value in substantiating an array of EP-based approaches and generates specific methods of its own for clinical application, which will be discussed.

We will discover how a seamless flow of energy refracts into four frequency domains and, through experiential exercises, how to work with these domains for optimal transformation for self and for clients. Included will be effective methods grounded in the multidimensional model, such as the potentized use of intention, how to discern energy from information, how to utilize energy and information in clinical practice, how to access higher dimensional energies, and ways to achieve more rapid results. By the end of the session participants will have a deeper understanding of the science of energy, information and consciousness, and how to work with these forces in a therapeutic setting.
